About the event:

Impact of your contribution:

About Cars for Neighbors:

The mission of Cars for Neighbors is fostering independence by providing car care. Located in Anoka County, MN, Cars for Neighbors is a nonprofit organization that provides assistance to neighbors seeking economic self-sufficiency. We provide help with car repair services, and we also donate vehicles to clients referred to us by social workers at local nonprofits we partner with such as Alexandra House, Tepping Home Emergency Housing, Family Promise in Anoka County, etc. We do this so neighbors in need can get to work, take their children to medical appointments, and participate in educational opportunities. This is achieved through a small organizational structure with many strong and critical partnerships and numerous volunteers. We pull this network together to help neighbors become more self-sufficient, restoring hope one car at a time. Since inception in 2000 we have been able to donate over 1,040 vehicles and repair over 3,700.
